Free Water Conservation House Calls Available in Sacramento


As summer temperatures rise, many Sacramento households are looking for ways to conserve water—and the City is offering a free, easy way to help. Sacramento's Water Conservation Team is providing complimentary house calls to residents who want to reduce their water use and lower their bills.

These visits are especially recommended for households using more than 500 gallons of water per day, which you can check on your monthly utility bill. During the visit, a trained water conservation specialist will walk through your home and yard to identify opportunities to save water. They'll help you program your sprinkler timer, inspect for leaks, and offer free watersaving tools like high-efficiency showerheads and faucet aerators.

In addition, residents can get pre-qualified for rebates on water-saving upgrades such as efficient irrigation systems or weather-based controllers.

Whether you're looking to cut back on outdoor watering or simply want to do your part during the dry season, this free service is a great place to start.

Did you know your child might already have money set aside for their future education—and you didn't have to lift a finger? The State of California is investing in our kids through a program called CalKIDS, which helps families start saving for college or career training through free 529 education savings accounts. Here's the details:

- Certain public school students in California (grades 1–12 as of Fall 2021) qualified based on their household income and a CalKIDS account was created automatically with an initial deposit.
- Babies born on or after July 1, 2022, and registered with the state, also automatically qualify for an initial deposit of \$25 to \$100, with potential bonus awards.

 There's nothing you need to do to enroll—just visit <u>CalKIDS.org</u> to look up your child's account and see what's waiting for them!

What can the money be used for?

Funds in a CalKIDS 529 account can be used for a wide range of education-related expenses—not just college! That includes trade schools, community colleges, books, supplies, fees, and other qualified costs associated with education or training after high school.

CalKIDS also offers matching incentives and scholarships—so the sooner you activate your child's account, the more opportunities you may unlock.

Let's spread the word—our community's future is worth it!



311 Sacramento is the city's nonemergency service line and app for reporting issues like potholes, graffiti, or missed trash pickups.
